The Killough/Kellough Family of Gays River and surrounding area in Nova Scotia

I became interested in this family because of my research into the McMullen family of the same area¹. One of the early McMullen women (Margaret Moody, d/o Mary McMullen) married Thomas Killough of Gays River, and in looking for their children I ended up pulling together a draft genealogy of this family, since it is an uncommon name and there were only a few families. However, there are Killough/Kellough families in the Gays River area - William (b. 1825, md Elizabeth McHeffey²) and Thomas (b. 1819, md Margaret Moody) are sons of William Sr. (b. 1786) and Martha who came to Gays River, also I believe Andrew Kellough who married Mary Amelia Kilcup and lived in Gore, Hants Co. is another son; but I have not connected them with Thomas (b. 1804, md Janet Henderson) – he may be a nephew or younger brother of William Sr. This Thomas had a son Robert Henderson Kellough in Gays River, who married Henrietta Cook and they have many descendants.

I found the early records to be mostly Killough, but then in the later records Kellough seems to be more predominant.

So this report is very much an early draft version and I would appreciate any feedback. I start with the William and Martha Kellough family, then on page 23 I have the Thomas and Jennet (Henderson) Kellough family. Most of the data is from Nova Scotia Historical Vital Statistics (NSHVS; <u>www.novascotiagenealogy.com</u>), from Canadian census data, from cemetery inscriptions, and from Massachusetts vital records (<u>www.familysearch.org</u>).

I also want to share links for the broader Killough family and the Killough Reunion Association at <u>http://killough.org</u> They prepared a book, "The Killough/Kellough Family in Ireland, Canada and the United States", by Zora Killough Cunningham, 1997. The database is online at

Nova Scotia is not mentioned in this book. Chapter 12 contains one of the Irish/Canadian Branches, which is an Ontario family. James (1798-1869) emigrated from Antrim, Ireland to Lanark Co., Ontario in 1834. His father is buried near Ballymoney, Antrim, which interestingly enough is where Mary Ann (Kellough) Wright of Seattle, WA claimed her father, Robert Kellough of Gays River, was from (see #4 in the Thomas and Jennet Henderson Kellough family below). This family was in the Almonte/Ottawa area, and some generations migrated to the US. A DNA match has been made between a descendant of this Ontario family and a descendant of the Gays River family. James' brother John (p. 337) also emigrated first to Lanark Co. ("where the other Killoughs were"), then to Holland Landing, ON, and generations from there to Saskatchewan and British Columbia. So while the details have yet to be worked out, this provides a tentative linkage for the Nova Scotia family all the way back to John Killough, b. 1630, of Droghega Scotland.

Son of Andrew and Mary Killough (NSHVS). I think likely William and Martha Killough came to Gays River with children, I would guess in the early 1840s.

William married **Martha**. Born in 1787. Martha died in Gays River, Nova Scotia on 31 Jan 1862; she was 75. Buried in Gays River United Church Cemetery, NS. KILLOUGH Martha Jan. 31, 1862 age 75 yrs. wife of Wm. KILLOUGH

Thomas married **Margaret (Peggy) Ann Moody**, daughter of James Moody & Mary McMullen (1799-). Born in 1822 in Ireland. Margaret (Peggy) Ann died in Antrim, NS, on 17 May 1871; she was 49. James and Mary Moody were married and had family in Ireland, then moved to Halifax County to join her father Archibald McMullen and five brothers who had emigrated in the early 1820s to Antrim (Nuttle Hill), Halifax County.

In 1858 when William was 33, he married **Elizabeth Church McHeffey**, daughter of **John McHeffey**³ (1800-3 Sep 1890) & **Isabella J. McHeffey** (1803-11 May 1880), in Gays River, NS. Born on 20 Oct 1832 in Gays River, NS. Elizabeth Church died in Lake Egmont, Hfx. Co., NS, on 24 Mar 1919; she was 86. Buried in Gays River United Church Cemetery, NS.

William, the third son of Richard and Mary (Caulfield) McHeffey, was born in Ireland on Aug. 10, 1765. He died May 1, 1823. He married Elizabeth Ann Church. She was born in 1770 and died July 30, 1832. They raised a family of four sons and four daughters, Anne (William Dowling), Elizabeth (Frank McDonald), Sophia (Josiah Gilbert), Margaret (George Corbett), Edward (Euphemia Macdonald), Robin (Maria Curry), John and William.

John, son of William and Elizabeth Ann (Church) McHeffey, was born in Shubenacadie. He married his first cousin Isabel, daughter of James McHeffey. John and Isabel are the parents of Elizabeth.

Murray McLean Kellough was born on a farm near Lake Egmont, Nova Scotia, on 21 February 1874, the youngest son of William and Elizabeth Kellough. As a young man he moved to Halifax and worked in the grocery business. He subsequently worked in the same field in Boston and Winnipeg. He lost his Winnipeg business during the Great Depression and subsequently worked a small farm in Selkirk, Manitoba, growing experimental crops and studying at the University of Manitoba. On 30 January 1907 he married Jessie Russell Phillips of Halifax and together they had three children. His wife died on 21 January 1919 from influenza and his children were sent back to Nova Scotia for a year. Thereafter, they returned and his wife's older sister, Annie Blanche Phillips, helped to raise the children. Ultimately, Murray Kellough moved back to a small farm on the edge of Winnipeg. He died there on 27 July 1965.

NS Archives Fonds consists of a pass for access for the devastated area issued by the City of Halifax and a sixteen page hand-written letter by Ethel Jean Bond to her uncle, Murray Kellough, of Winnipeg, Manitoba. In her letter she describes the devastation of the Halifax Explosion, the death of her father, and the injuries that her sister Bertha sustained, and discusses the impact on various neighbours in the vicinity of Kaye Street in Halifax, including the Swetnams, Killams, and Theakstons, among others.
