The Kerr Family of Halifax County, Nova Scotia

The Kerr family settled in Antrim, Halifax County (Guysborough Road), Nova Scotia after emigrating from Ireland. Some of the family later moved towards Milford Station and Gays River areas. This report traces their descendants through several generations. It is not complete but should help readers trace their connections to this family.





Land grants of 200 acres (Old No 1032 Bk H p 62, No 1) and 100 acres (Bk K p 30 No 4) to John Kerr immediately north of the grant to Archibald McMullen on the Antrim Road, off the Guysborough Road east of Devon, Halifax County. This map also shows Kerr Lake.

Four land grants to James G. Kerr -63 acres south of Buckley Lake, 105 acres between those of John Hamilton and William Hill south of the Guysborough Road (left side) and two grants just west of Dollar Lake and south of the grant to John Wise.

First Generation

1. John Kerr. Born in Antrim, Ireland. John died in Guysborough Road (Devon), Halifax Co. Buried in Old Cemetery at Gays River.

John was from the Kerr family of Clintyfinnan, Antrim - see research done by Andrew Kerr of Cardiff, Wales - "The Carrstoon Kerrs, A Family History" (2020).

From "History Along the Old Guysborough Road", by Annie Blois Smith and Noreen E. Gray, 1987. "John Kerr and his wife Ann Guthrie of Antrim Parish Withstrow, Ireland (near Londonderry) came out to Nova Scotia in 1816 and took up land on the Guysborough Road near the Antrim crossroads. It was believed they were the first settlers on this section of the Guysborough Road and that the village of Antrim received its name from this family. John Kerr died young leaving his wife with six children, Samuel, Jane, Ann, James and John, the name of the sixth is unknown. James Kerr married Jane Mullen and this couple operated Kerr's Inn near the Antrim crossroads. The Kerr Inn was a welcome sight to the weary traveler of the 1860s as it was the last resting place on the route to Musquodoboit. James Kerr and his family lived a busy life for besides operating the inn and farm, they operated a small grocery store and post office. Teachers from the nearby Antrim school also boarded here. We were informed that the road from Kerr's onward toward Musquodoboit was passable at best and in the spring the conditions were deplorable. Spring flooding often caused wash outs so that stage coaches would be held up for days at the inn awaiting better road conditions or for the repairs to wheels and axles."

The Kerr genealogy (Smith, Mabel. 1971. The Genealogy of John Kerr and Ann Guthrie. Updated by Brenda Reid in July, 1986) says they came at the same time as the McMullen's¹, and on the Guysborough Road they were neighbours. The McMullen's came from Derrykeigan, Antrim, which is only 7 miles from Clintyfinnan Road. They must have all known each other. Along with the McMullen's were the McFetridge's and the Redmond's, all within the same small radius in Ballykeigan and all settled on the Guysborough Road, "New Antrim", NS.

From Terry Whalley, Jan. 2007, "John Kerr (pioneer) came to NS at age 46 to manage the summer estate of Lord Dalhousie."

Jean Kerr (1781-1862) married John McMichael (1780-1867) and they emigrated at the same time to the same area and were of the same age. Mary Jane McMichael, d/o Jean Kerr, married John Kerr Jr., son of John Sr. I could easily guess that Jean (Kerr) McMichael was a sister of John Kerr Sr. Please see my McMichael register.²

John married **Ann Guthrie**. Born in 1780 in Antrim, Ireland. Ann died in Guysborough Road (Devon), Halifax Co., in 1867; she was 87. Buried in Gays River Church Cemetery.

She is said to have been from the Parish of Withstrow. Probably a niece or other relative of Jennet Guthrie (b. 1738),

married to Alexander McCurdy.³ There are several Kerr-McCurdy connections between these two families:

• Susan A. H. McCurdy, d/o James Munro McCurdy³ (James², Alexander¹) married James Guthrie Kerr³, son of James Kerr² (John¹) & Jane Millen.

Alexander married **Jennet Guthrie**. Born in 1738. Jennet died on 12 May 1800; she was 62. She was from the Parish of Withstrow. Possibly an aunt or other relative of Ann Guthrie (b. 1780), married to John Kerr. Alexander and Jennet McCurdy settled in Onslow Township, Nova Scotia.

On 25 Dec 1788 when James was 22, he married Agnes Archibald, daughter of Matthew Archibald (9 Mar 1745-18 Jan 1820) & Janet Fisher (ca 1749-5 Mar 1843). Born on 26 Nov 1770 in Truro, Colchester Co., NS. Agnes died on 2 May 1851; she was 80. From Miller, T. (1873), "They had seven sons and seven daughters. This was a remarkable family, as there was not a death in it until all the family were married and had families. Two of the sons were ministers of the gospel and the other five were all elected Elders of the Presbyterian Church."
- iii. Daniel. Born on 1 Apr 1768 in Londonderry Twp., NS. Daniel died in Onslow Twp., NS, on 18 Jul 1815; he was 47. Buried in Burial Island, Onslow. On 4 Aug 1792 when Daniel was 24, he married Eunice Wright in Onslow, Colchester Co., NS.
- iv. **Margaret**. Born on 20 Mar 1770 in Londonderry, Col. Co., NS. Margaret died in 1801; she was 30. Residence: Onslow, NS.

Margaret married **William Taylor**, son of **Matthew Taylor** (30 Oct 1727-22 Jan 1796) & **Elizabeth Archibald** (20 Jun 1726-4 Feb 1809). Born on 7 Nov 1771 in Truro, Colchester Co., NS. William died in St. Mary's, NS, in 1840; he was 68.

v. Alexander. Born in 1773. Residence: USA.

Alexander married Lydia Gourley.

vi. **Robert**. Born on 24 Sep 1775 in Onslow, Colchester Co., NS. Robert died in Onslow, Colchester Co., NS, on 16 Sep 1863; he was 87.

In 1794 when Robert was 18, he married **Susanna Lynds**, daughter of **Thomas Lynds** (1747-6 Jan 1839) & **Rebecca Blair** (1757-9 Jan 1838). Born on 2 Sep 1776. Susanna died in Onslow, Colchester Co., NS, on 18 Jan 1862; she was 85.

vii. **Jennet Guthrie**. Born on 8 Nov 1777 in Onslow, Col. Co., NS. Jennet Guthrie died on 12 Dec 1848; she was 71. Buried in Burial Island, Onslow.

On 20 Aug 1801 when Jennet Guthrie was 23, she married **Luke Upham**. Born on 5 Feb 1783 in Onslow, Col. Co., NS. Luke died in Onslow, Col. Co., NS, on 16 Aug 1854; he was 71.

"They first came to Windsor, Nova Scotia, from there they crossed over the Bay of Fundy and settled in Londonderry, where they lived for some years. In 1770 their family consisted of Alexander, his wife and four children. They then owned a large tract, 1500 acres of the best land in the Township. Alexander McCurdy was an Elder in the Presbyterian Church for 20 years. Jennet McCurdy, wife of Alexander McCurdy was born in the Parish of Withstrow in the north of Ireland."

From Mabel Smith's Kerr genealogy, "Samuel Kerr, 1804-1880, lived at Antrim, Nova Scotia, married Margaret McKeen, second daughter of John and Isabel (Thompson) McKeen, who kept an Inn at Gay's River. Mrs. John McKeen, mother of Margaret, died suddenly in her early forties. Her eldest daughter was to marry James Etter of Shubenacadie and Mrs. McKeen and Eliza Ann, the bride-to-be, went to Halifax to purchase her trousseau. Their mission accomplished, the excitement and fatigue proved too much for Mrs. McKeen. She died on the street of a cerebral hemorrhage, leaving several quite young children. Eliza Ann married James Etter in four months time, but Margaret, engaged to Samuel Kerr, took her mother's place and refused to marry until after the death of her little invalid brother."

Ted was born at home in Stewiacke on January 5,1922 to Nellie (Gould) and Rufus Dickie. His childhood was full of adventure with his 3 brothers, 2 sisters, a pet bear named Billy, and a team of great Dane dogs whose leader Danny would haul Dad and his siblings around town in a sleigh. His playground was the "Canadian Lumber Co." which was one of the biggest logging operations in N.S. at the time. His growing-up years spanned the Great Depression, the tail end of the Age of Iron Men and Wooden ships and the space between two World Wars. Dad was greatly influenced by all three events and had many stories of the exploits and strengths of the company loggers who still used taxes, buck saws and horses to get the logs out. Much time was spent at Clam Harbour, at the family cottage, where he met the love of his life at the age of 13 - Florence MacKinnon - and promptly married her in a mock wedding on the beach. Many events would transpire before their real wedding in 1949, including getting his pilot's license on his 17th birthday, finishing school and earning a BSc at Mount Allison University, where he narrowly escaped death when his residence burned down. He was a 2nd Lieutenant in the Cadet Officers Training Corp there. He later graduated from McGill University as a Mechanical Engineer and began work in the Canadian Lumber Company, first in Stewiacke, then in mill sites at Barney's River, Glenelg, NS and Gillis Dale. Ted and Flo had three children, Paul (Maxine), Mark, and Jan (Fred Watkins). When Paul was of school age, they moved from the mill camps to Stewiacke. He graduated with a degree in medicine from McGill University in Montreal, Canada in 1944, having won the John Munro Elder Prize for Honors studies in anatomy. He received his Masters degree in 1946 and a PhD degree in 1948. He was a Markel Scholar in Medical Science and began his research career with investigations of human and experimental atherosclerosis. Among his early work was the paradoxical observation that experimental diabetes, induced by alloxan, inhibited the atherosclerosis resulting from feeding cholesterol to a rabbit. As a result of this fundamental research, it became known that some lipoprotein particles are atherogenic whereas others are not, and it likely caused the speculation that the cause of atherosclerosis was far more complicated than being solely caused by too much cholesterol in the blood. He also studied the effects of undernutrition and of cortisone on cholesterol-induced atherosclerosis. He served as Strathcona Professor of Pathology and became Chairman of the Department of Pathology at McGill University. He was also chief of Pathology at the Royal Victoria Hospital in 1957, and a consulting pathologist, through 1966, to the Royal Edward Laurentian Hospital, the Montreal Neurological Institute, the Montreal Children's Hospital, the Montreal General Hospital, and the Jewish Hospital of Hope. He became a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (Pathology) in 1964. He continued to study human and experimental atherosclerosis, reporting on the effects of saturated, unsaturated, and trans-fatty acids in cholesterol-fed rabbits and on amino acid deficiencies. He received the AHA Citation for Distinguished Service to Research in 1965. He joined the National Institutes of Health (NIH) in 1966, first as a consultant and then as special assistant to the Director of the Heart Institute (1968), as Chief of the Arteriosclerosis Diseases Branch, and, between 1972 and 1991, as Director of the Arteriosclerosis, Hypertension, and Lipid Metabolism Program at the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute. Through his efforts, the NIH pioneered research programs on nutrition, lesion dynamics, and the relationship of hemodynamics to atherogenesis, which led to the establishment of nonhuman primate resources. He retired in 1991.

He was survived by his wife, Lois Ellen Dickie McMillan; two sons and their spouses; two daughters and their spouses; and eight grandchildren.
